Human Anatomy

54 hours lecture, 54 hours laboratory

This course is the study of the structures of the human body. This course provides the basic knowledge and lab skills to meet the needs of pre-nursing, physical education, physical therapy, and other allied health majors. Dissection of a cat or mink is required.

Anatomy & Physiology

72 hours lecture, 54 hours laboratory

Grading: letter grade or pass/no pass.

This course is an introduction to the study of the structures and functions of the human body. Knowledge learned in lecture is reinforced by laboratory experiments and dissections. This course is designed for students in certain health related majors as well as students not majoring in the life sciences. Dissection of the fetal pig is required.
